WFH! A New Acronym on Everyone's lips these days. Being in a Public Sector Unit for my entire professional life, I had a zero experience of WFH. However, due to the corona virus outbreak, I have finally understood and experienced this so called bliss.

First of all, it took me a minute to understand the difference between "WFH" & "W#F". These acronyms were so similar in their spelling. Silly me!!

WFH means "Work for Home" and W#F means....

Oh I think you must all be already aware of the so famous meaning.

Corona Virus Outbreak had made "WFH" possible. A working culture completely unfamiliar to a professional form Public Sector Unit. Moreover, almost a month of WFH expected at this present moment after our PM announced 21 days of lockdown on 26-03-2020.

23rd March 2020 was my first day of WFH in my entire life.
